### **Tiffin Board of Education Appoints Dr. Joanna Beres to Fill Vacant Seat**

Tiffin, OH – The Tiffin City Schools Board of Education has appointed Dr. Joanna Beres to fill the board seat vacated by Dustin Williams, who resigned effective September 1 because he is moving outside the district.

Williams' term was set to expire at the end of this year. The Board expressed gratitude for his service and noted that his early departure created an opportunity to allow his successor to begin serving immediately.

In accordance with Board policy, the vacancy was addressed within the required 10- to 30-day window. Following consultation with board members and Superintendent Jerry Nadeau, the Board determined that Dr. Beres, who is running unopposed for the seat in the November election, was the logical candidate to complete the unexpired term.

Dr. Beres is a parent in the district and serves as an Assistant Professor of Chemistry and Forensic Science at Tiffin University. She earned her B.S. in Chemistry from Walsh University in 2006 and her Ph.D. in Inorganic Chemistry from the University of Akron in 2011. Her career has included work as a chemist for the City of Canton's Water Reclamation Facility and teaching positions at the University of Toledo and the University of Findlay before joining Tiffin University in 2023.
